

# The Bible in 90 Days

## ***Bible Study Marking System Ideas***

### **Symbol System**

As a Bible in 90 Days Challenge participant, I used the following symbols to mark my Bible with insights, interests and key passages that I wanted to follow up on after I completed each day's Bible in 90 Days readings.

- \* (star) = denotes: God Speaking to me.
- ? (question mark) = denotes: Come back to this section and explore in more detail later.  
i.e. What is the prophet saying here?
- (dot) = next to a verse or passage is a reminder of motivation/insight.

Some people look at using The Bible in 90 Days as a single use learning tool and want to write notes and apply post-it notes throughout the Bible to mark specific findings and features. Others of you may not like marking their Bible with symbols and notes. You can choose what your Bible study preference is based on your interests.

### **Post-it Note System**

Color Post-it flags can be used to mark various sections of Bible text during your Bible reading. For example, when you feel like highlighting a specific verse or section of Bible text, you may choose to use a specific color to indicate whether the text is inspiration, new knowledge, personal insight, or favorite Bible verses. You can also use post-it notes with arrows and graphics to assist you with noting sections of your Bible text during your 90 day readings.
